

## COVID-19 procedure EKG @HVF

Pre entries are due 5 days before day of show to [eringrampp@aol.com](mailto:eringrampp@aol.com). Entry forms are available at [www.ekgstables.com](http://www.ekgstables.com). Forms need to be completed with signatures and submitted via email only. If you enter, please attend since ride times will be impacted. If you plan to pay in cash, please bring exact change. No change will be given. Checks are accepted made out to Hill Valley Farm. Please limit the number of people using secretary services (i.e. one person per barn) to pick up numbers, return numbers, and pick up ribbons.

Courses will be posted on the EKG Stables Facebook page prior to the show, on the website, as well as posted at the in-gate.

Ride times will be posted on website and Facebook page by Friday at 8am before show.

There will be a brief schooling break prior to each division for that division only. The jump heights will be set so there will be no touching the jumps by anyone who is not horse show staff.

No ribbons will be distributed at the ring. Please keep track of your awards. At checkout, please ask for your ribbons then.

Only riders and trainers will be permitted ringside. We realize parents need to be present on the grounds for minors, but please limit the number of parents or guardians to 2 and remain socially distant in viewing areas. Please watch the show from the parking area, parking lot, or pre-determined viewing areas with ring view. Siblings, friends, or other spectators will not be permitted on the show grounds. We are limited in the number people on the grounds so please adhere to these guidelines.

**All present on the show grounds, whether part of the show, guest, or boarder at the facility, will be required to wear masks or face coverings if within 6ft of another person not within your family unit. While riding, masks are not required. When mounted face coverings not required.**

Please leave dogs at home.

When not competing, please remain at your trailer maintaining proper social distancing from others. No gathering in large groups near or away from the competition ring.

Once you have finished competing, please depart the grounds in a timely manner.

There will be a Porta John ringside and hand wipe stations at the secretary stand, near Porta John, and at ringside.

Please dispose of all trash in the trash cans provided.

Trainers and/or barns are subject to expulsion from the grounds if guidelines are not followed. Please discuss with each individual in your group the importance of following rules and the direction of horse show staff.

The following COVID-19 Guidelines must be adhered to when competing and/or attending our competitions. In addition, all Federal, State, and local laws that may be applicable must be followed. Management reserves the right to change the guidelines when/if it is necessary. Failure to follow guidelines may result in expulsion from the show grounds. The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus.

If you plan to come to the competition grounds, you must be able to assure management that neither you, nor anyone in your household:

1. Has tested positive or has been presumed positive for COVID-19 at any time during the past 14 days
2. Has been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine at any time during the past 14 days
3. Has been in close physical contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has been presumed positive for COVID-19, during the past 14 days
4. Is subject to a quarantine order or a recommendation of a healthcare professional that, in either case, would make it inadvisable to attend a public event or competition.
5. Has, within the past 24 hours, exhibited any of the following symptoms: fever of 100.4 or greater, cough, shortness of breath.

Please adhere to all social distancing guidelines and be mindful of your surroundings. We are all in this together and need to all do our part to make this day safe for all.
